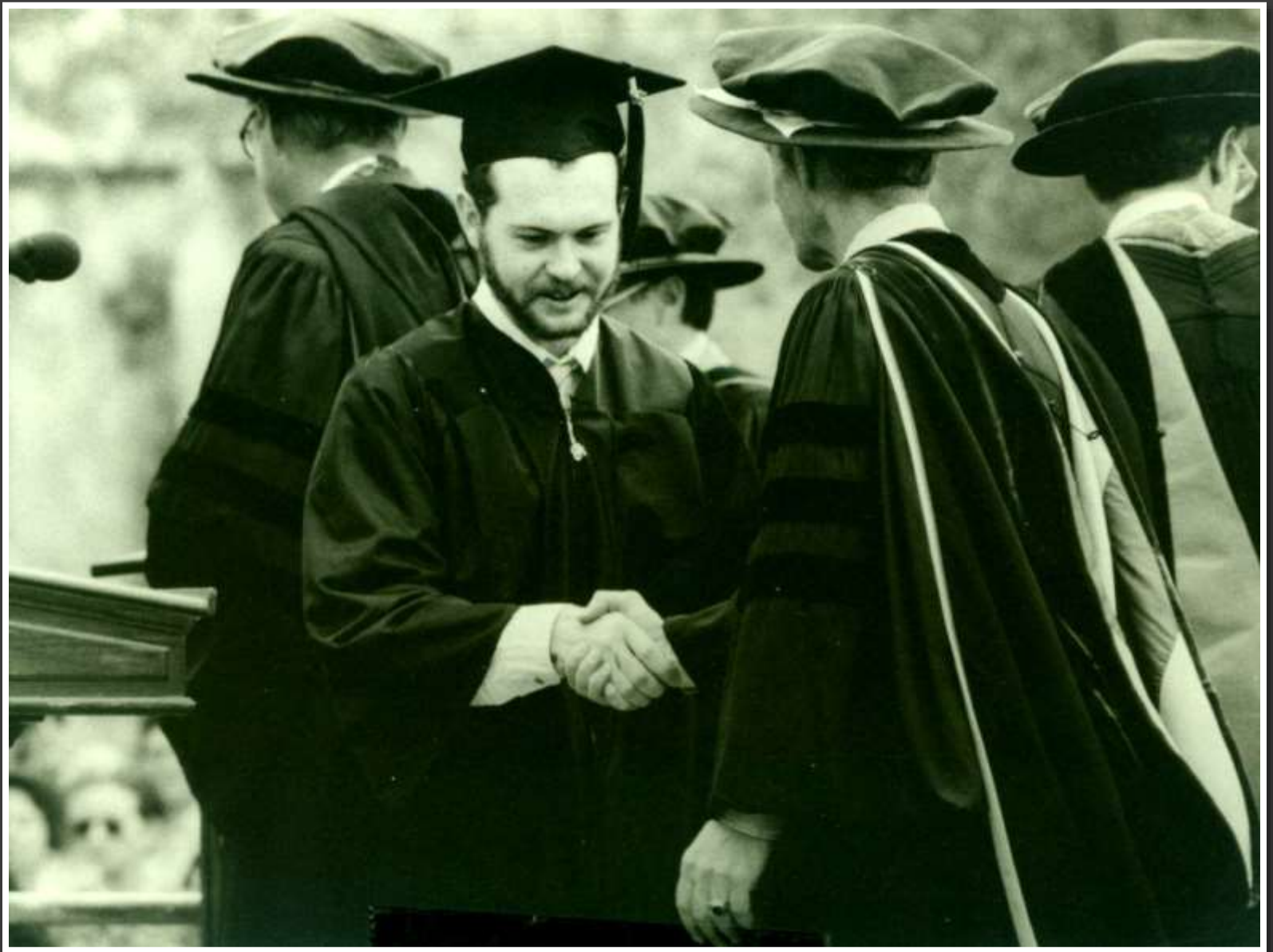

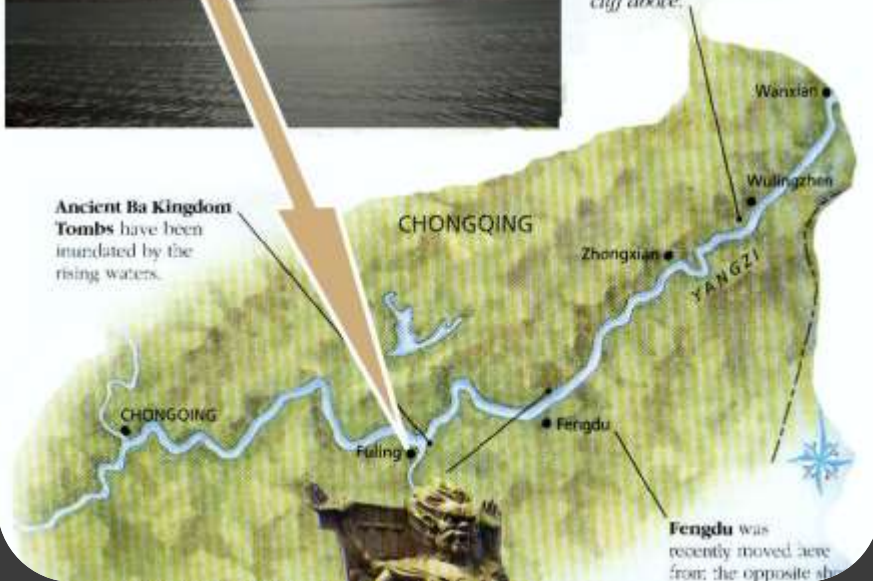

Fengdu was recently moved here from the opposite shore.





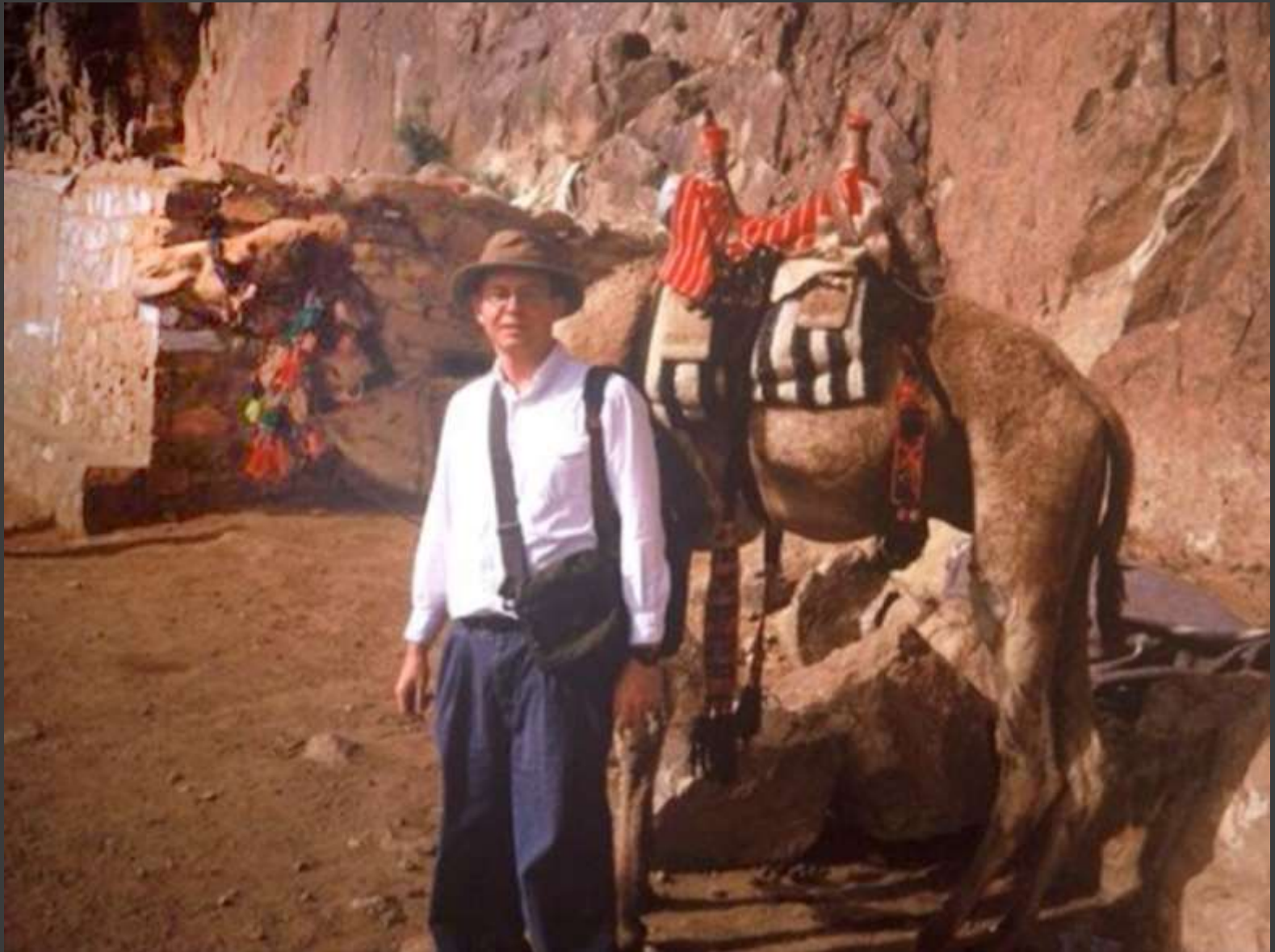

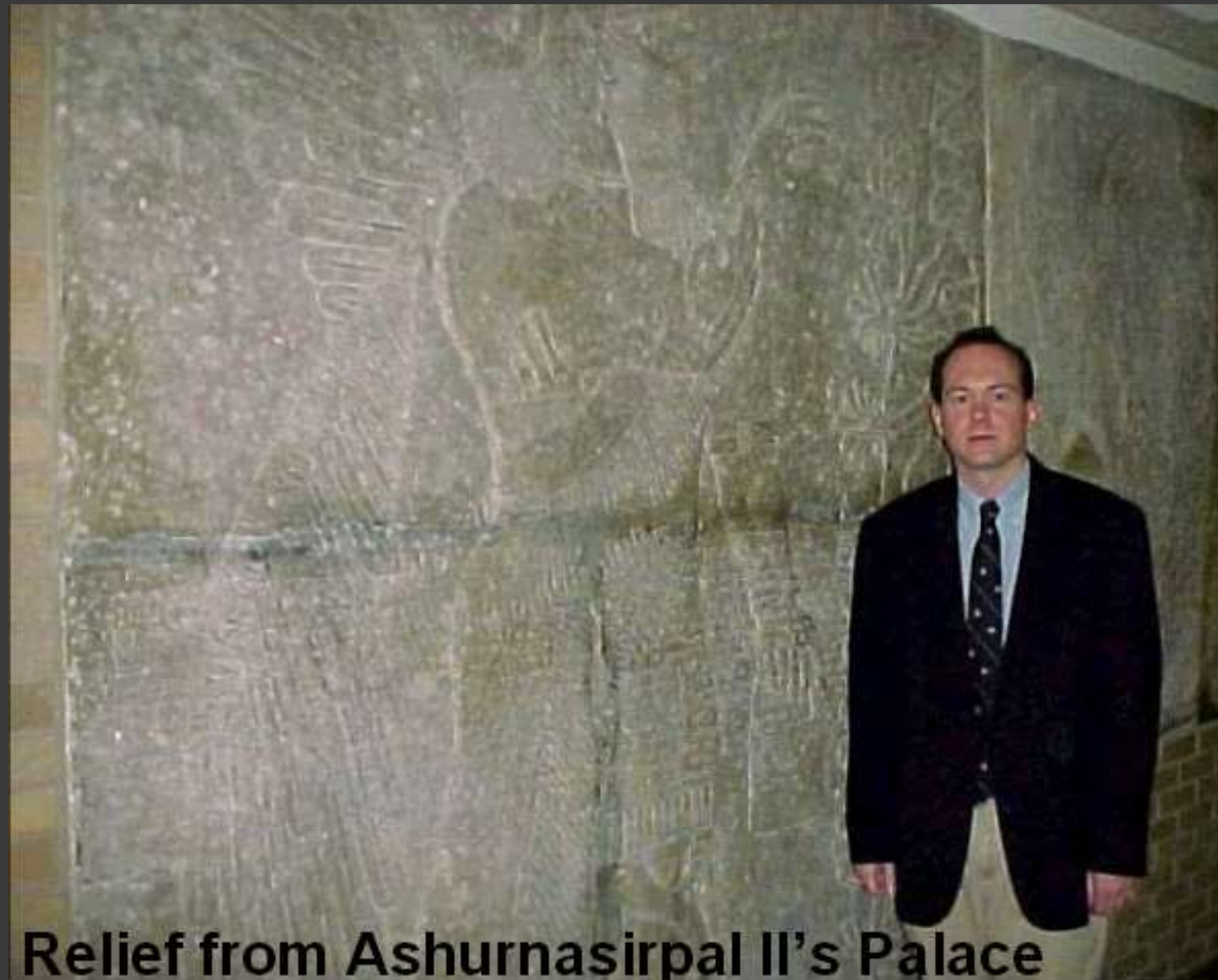
